AFFIDAVIT

Special Agent Brian E. Cooney, Federal Bureau of Investigation, after being duly sworn, deposes and says the following:

- 1. On October 31, 2008, a warrant was issued in 52/1 District Court, Oakland
 County, Novi, Michigan, charging Lakshminivasa Rao Nerusu, defendant herein,
 with Three Counts of Homicide Murder First Degree Premeditated, which are
 felonies under the laws of the State of Michigan. The Novi Police Department
 (NPD) is currently holding a valid warrant for the arrest of the defendant on the
 charges stated above based on the alleged crimes.
- 2. On November 4, 2008, the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney, Oakland County, Pontiac, Michigan, requested assistance from the Federal Bureau of Investigation, in effort to locate and apprehend the defendant based on the recommendation of the Novi Police Department.
- Investigation conducted by the NPD has revealed that on October 13, 2008, the
 defendant allegedly murdered his wife, Jayalashmi Nerusu, his daughter, Tejasvi
 Nerusu, and his son, Siva Nerusu, in their apartment located at 29567 Wharton
 Court, Novi, Michigan 48375.
- 4. Further investigation conducted by NPD has developed information that the defendant used cash to purchase a one way flight to India on October 13, 2008 with the intent and purpose of avoiding prosecution on charges of the alleged crime. The defendant departed Detroit Metro Airport on Lufthansa Flight 443 at 3:50 pm on October 14, 2008 for Frankfurt Germany arriving at 5:55 am. The defendant then departed Frankfurt Germany on Lufthansa Flight 752 at 11:00 am

on October 15, 2008 for Hyderabad, India arriving at 11:15 pm. This matter has received media attention in the Detroit Metropolitan area as well as in India and to date, the defendant continues to remain in a wanted status.

5. The above is known to the undersigned to be true through reliable information obtained from results of investigation conducted by the Novi Police Department and the affiant.
